There are “regular” white wines on one end of the spectrum; on the other end, you’ll find flor-influenced wines that taste more like a dry fino sherry. The more flor there is, the more you will want to pair this wine with shellfish...

Petit Manseng in France & Virginia

"There is a lot of clay in Jurançon, and humidity. It's very similar to here."

~Matthieu Finot, winemaker at King Family Vineyards in Crozet, Virginia

We rarely see Petit Manseng outside of its home in southwest France, particularly in the Jurançon. Aside from a few scattered plantings throughout the world, if you look at Petit Manseng's diaspora, it pretty much consists of Virginia. Petit Manseng has open clusters that allow for airflow, which is perfect for the humid climate you'll find in the Jurançon and in Virginia.

- 1562 ~ 'mansengue' is mentioned in Jurançon text
- c1562-1780s ~ It is highly likely that a seed from a Manseng plant grew to become Gros Manseng, with the parent later distinguished as Petit Manseng
- c1783 ~ Petit Manseng is distinguished from Gros Manseng in text
- 1987 ~ Professor of Viticulture Tony Wolf (Virginia Tech) brings Petit Manseng from New York to Virginia to evaluate varieties for Virginia's climate
- 2000 ~ Michael Heny and Graham Bell makes a Petit Manseng wine at Horton Vineyards
- 2002 ~ Jennifer McCloud of Chrysalis releases a 100% Petit Manseng bottling
- 2009 ~ about 2,500 acres of Petit Manseng in France
- 2011 ~ DNA findings imply that Petit Manseng is a parent of Gros Manseng
- 2011 ~ 69 acres of Petit Manseng in Virginia
- 2017 ~ 381 acres of Petit Manseng in Virginia
- 2018 ~ Virginia's Wisdom Oak Winery wins 'Double Gold' at the San Francisco International Wine Competition with their 2017 Petit Manseng

Sherries have inspired the likes of Edgar Alan Poe ('The Cask of the Amontillado') and helped drive the early cocktail movement in the 1800s (think 'Sherry Cobbler'). A dry sherry can be amazing with shellfish, and sweeter sherries pair well with cheeses and desserts.

Amber Wines of the World

Amber wine is skin-fermented white wine. It's a style of winemaking that once pervaded the known world, now used by only a few. These jewel-like wines are hotly debated in the wine world. Some wine experts disdain amber wines on the assumption that skin-contact wines display aromas and flavors of wine-making technique rather than terroir. These same Amber nay-sayers usually contradict themselves when they also say that terroir is best expressed in a traditional red ferment with heavy skin maceration, or that terroir is absent in a 'simple' rosé. Amber wines force us to re-examine the locus of terroir in wines made from white grapes—does terroir lie in the grape flesh? The seeds? The skins? It could be a combination...

Amber wine is 'oddball' at the moment, but I long for a day when it has its proper place at the table. And this place is with foods that a traditional white wine or red wine may not quite complement, such as poultry, pork, and fatty foods like foie gras. Amber wines often have the tannin structure of a pinot noir with the lightness of being of a white wine, and this allows them to occupy an alternate universe of food pairing with dishes that require in concurrence both delicacy and power.

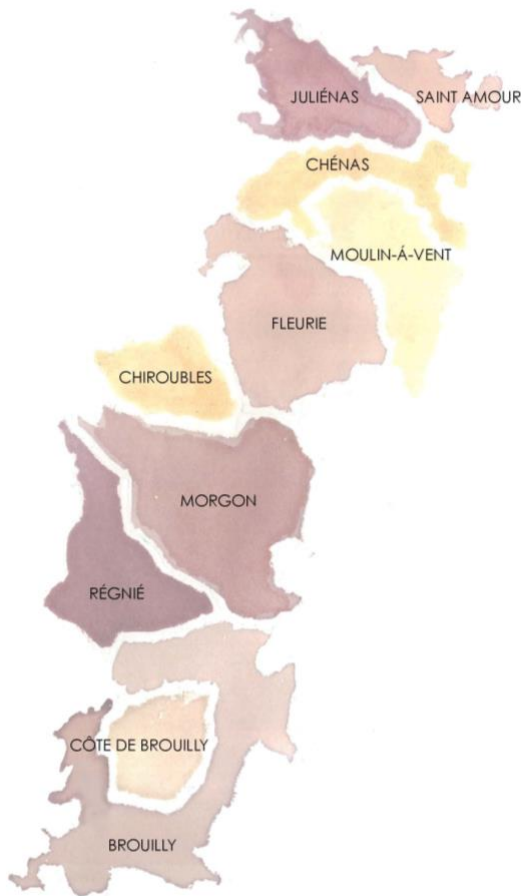

Featured Producers

Hervé Souhaut

Hervé Souhaut created Domaine Romaneaux-Destezet in 1993. Hervé works 5-hectares of old and ancient vines—

between 50 to 100 years old. He is very fortunate to own two vineyards in the Rhône Valley just opposite the storied hills of Hermitage in Saint Joseph. This region is widely recognized as being one of the finest areas for wine production on the planet; thanks in part to its elevation, ancient vineyard sites and the southeastern and southern exposures.

Hervé works entirely on whole grape bunches and semi-carbonic maceration. All of the vineyards are farmed organically, and no chemicals are added in the winemaking process. His philosophy is to extract a delicate balance of tannins from the grapes, to make a wine with subtlety and finesse. Hervé prefers to make a wine that is drinkable right away, but we must say his wines have such a fantastic level of purity and acidity, that the older bottles we have tasted have incredible potential to evolve into some of the most spectacular natural wines in existence.

Elk Cove

A Comparison of Single Vineyards

Elk Cove Vineyards was founded in 1974 by Pat and Joe Campbell. Winemaker Adam Campbell joined forces with his parents in 1995 and Elk Cove remains proudly family owned.

Mount Richmond Vineyard sits on marine sediment soil (Willakenzie) in the foothills of the Coast Range Mountains. In the heart of the Yamhill Carlton AVA. The vines were planted in a high-density format using cuttings of Pommard clone Pinot Noir taken directly from that esteemed block. An elevation of just 300 feet allows for earlier ripening.

Five Mountain Vineyard is set on a steep southeast facing slope in the Chehalem Mountains AVA, with a spectacular view of five volcanoes of the Cascade Range: Mount Hood, Mount St. Helens, Mount Rainier, Mount Jefferson, and Mount Adams. This historic vineyard on loess soil (Laurelwood/windblown silt) was planted in 1978 by the Ponzzi family and was purchased by Elk Cove in 2005.

Clay Court Vineyard is located in the picturesque Parrett Mountain area of the Chehalem Mountains AVA. Elk Cove purchased this great all Pinot Noir vineyard in 2009 because of its gentle southeast-facing slopes and signature dark red soil (Jory/volcanic clay). This 15-acre vineyard was planted in 2001 with Dijon 115 and 777, in addition to the historic Pommard clone of Pinot Noir. Clay Court is an ideal location for producing spicy Pinot Noir with concentrated red cherry fruit.

Lovingston - 'Gilbert's Vineyard' Pinotage 2017 \$60

This is one of the greatest wine values in Virginia. A playful offering reminds us of a wild, red fruit driven Pinot Noir. This Pinotage is grown on red clay slopes. This tasty bottling comes to us byway of the Puckett family & is crafted by the insightful winegrower, Riaan Rossouw. In the 1900s, a woman named Josie owned the knoll where the grape vines are planted, hence the wine's namesake...

King Family - Petit Verdot 2014 \$89

In 1996, the King family put down roots in Crozet and has been helping to define Virginia wine ever since. Winemaker Matthieu Finot brings a wealth of experience from his childhood in France. He has great success with Petit Verdot in the Monticello AVA. (658)

Barboursville - 'Octagon' Bordeaux Style Blend 2015 \$99

Winemaker Luca Paschina culls some very special grapes from Virginia's red clay to make this landmark wine. We call it a 'landmark' wine for a few reasons: it carries the mark of the land and represents the soils of the Monticello AVA. The label depicts a design by Thomas Jefferson of the ruins that rise up from the vineyards thus paying homage to the historic building and the echoes of Barboursville's past; and the wine itself is something of a landmark in Virginia's wine landscape (611)
